

## The problem

- The Pathways to Opportunity Plan sets the goal to make Virginia the best state for education by 2030.
- Virginia's current enrollment trends, inequities among disadvantaged groups, and low FAFSA completion rates are an obstacle to becoming the best state for education.


## The problem

- Every year 25,000 high school graduates do not enroll in postsecondary programs within sixteen months.
- Subgroups of students (minority, low income, ELs, students with disabilities) participate in postsecondary programs at lower rates.



## The problem

- Only 59 percent of high school seniors completed the FAFSA in 2019, making Virginia 23rd in the nation.
- Title I high schools experienced a 22.3% drop in FAFSA completion in 2020 the largest decline among any state

  - DE & AP (+18%)

- Virtual 1-on-1 FAFSAAssistance
  - SCHEV & VirginiaCAN partnership
  - Access providers provide virtual 1-on-1 FAFSA assistance to families



# New initiatives underway or in progress

#### Access

- Increased SCHEV's partnership with VDOE (through GPS/state funding)
- Awarded a \$24.7 million GEAR UP Virginia grant with new statewide focus (2021–2028)
- Establish(ed) a new partnership with VA529
- Develop and implement an Access Strategy Plan

• FAFSA Block Party February 19,2022 in Richmond

#### Planned activities to improve access & completion

#### Access

- Set an access and FAFSA completion goal potentially align with VDOE accreditation measures
- Expand career & college advising to every high school with 50% or more free and reduced priced lunch

#### FAFSA

- Establish a Governor's competition for FAFSA awareness
- Share student -level FAFSA data with high schools to better support completion efforts
- Support ongoing virtual FAFSA assistance
- Support parallel FAFSA system (VASA application)
