VASA Virginia Alternative State Aid Application

The Virginia Alternative State Aid (VASA) Application is an alternative option to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Who should file a VASA Application?

Virginians who are nonimmigrants, undocumented, have Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status or are otherwise ineligible to file the FAFSA and want to be considered for state financial aid.

Note: Students must meet domicile or Tuition Equity Provision requirements.

By filing a VASA Application...

- You will be taking an important step toward entering college financially prepared.
- You will be considered for state need-based financial aid; including the Commonwealth Award, Virginia Guaranteed Assistance Program and more!
- You will be considered for some public institution awards reserved for Virginia residents.
