





Demographic Changes

- Across the system, enrollment is down 1.3%, or 6,658 students
- At four-year public institutions:
 - Undergraduate enrollment is down 0.5%
 - Graduate enrollment is up 0.8%
 - First-year enrollment is down 10%
- Large variation among institutions (undergraduate +2% to -12%)


Fall Enrollment in Virginia Institutions by Sector



Note: Cost includes tuition, mandatory fees and room and board.


