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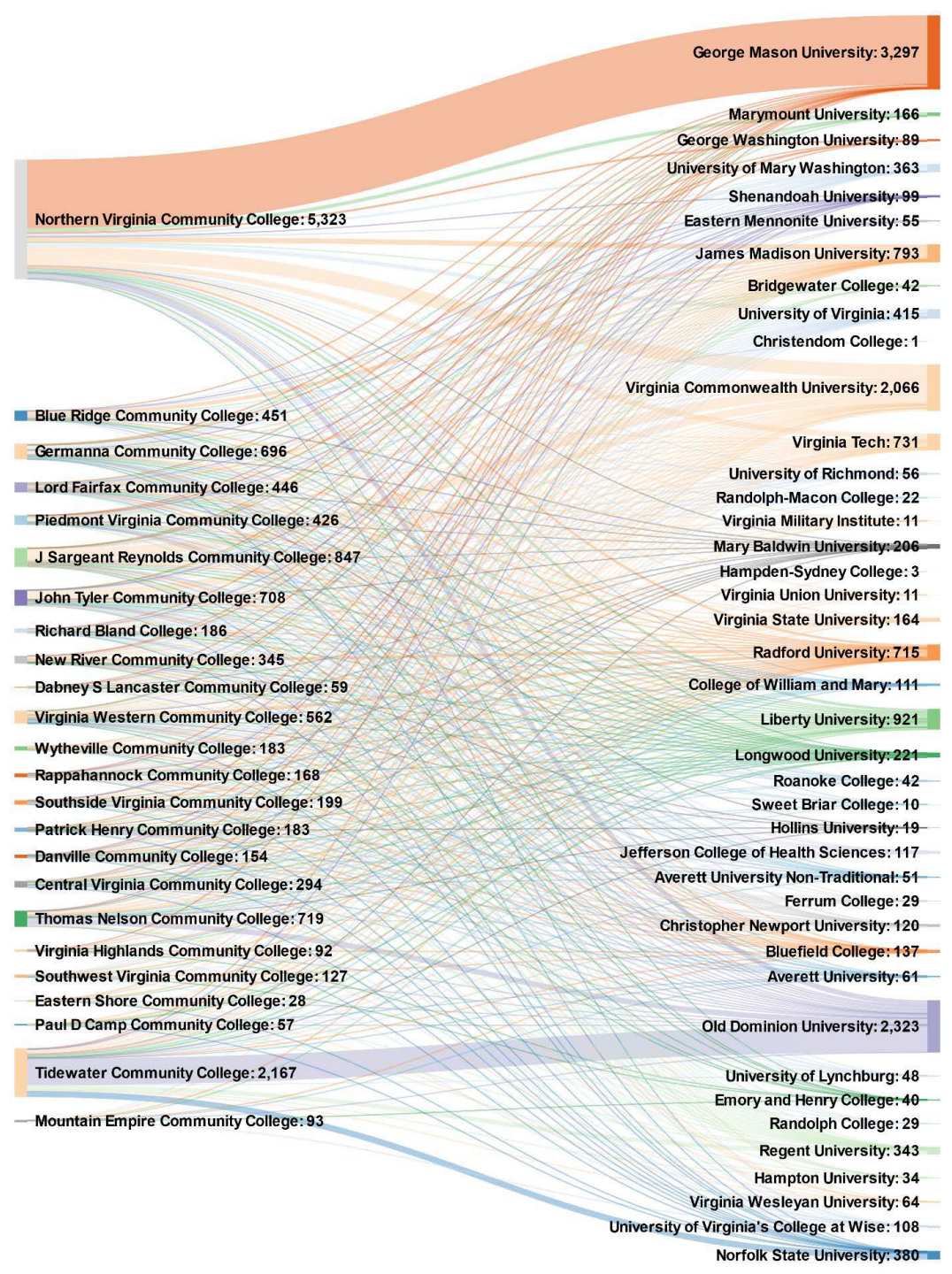

Mobility and timeliness: Improve time to transfer without reducing the number of students who complete an associate degree before transfer.

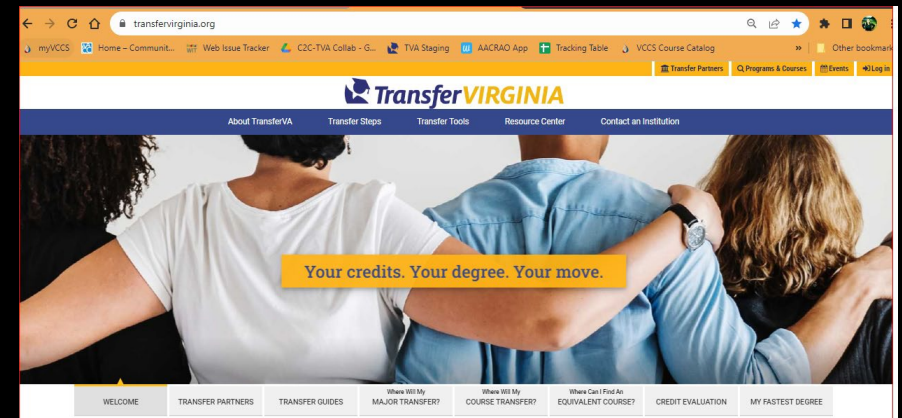
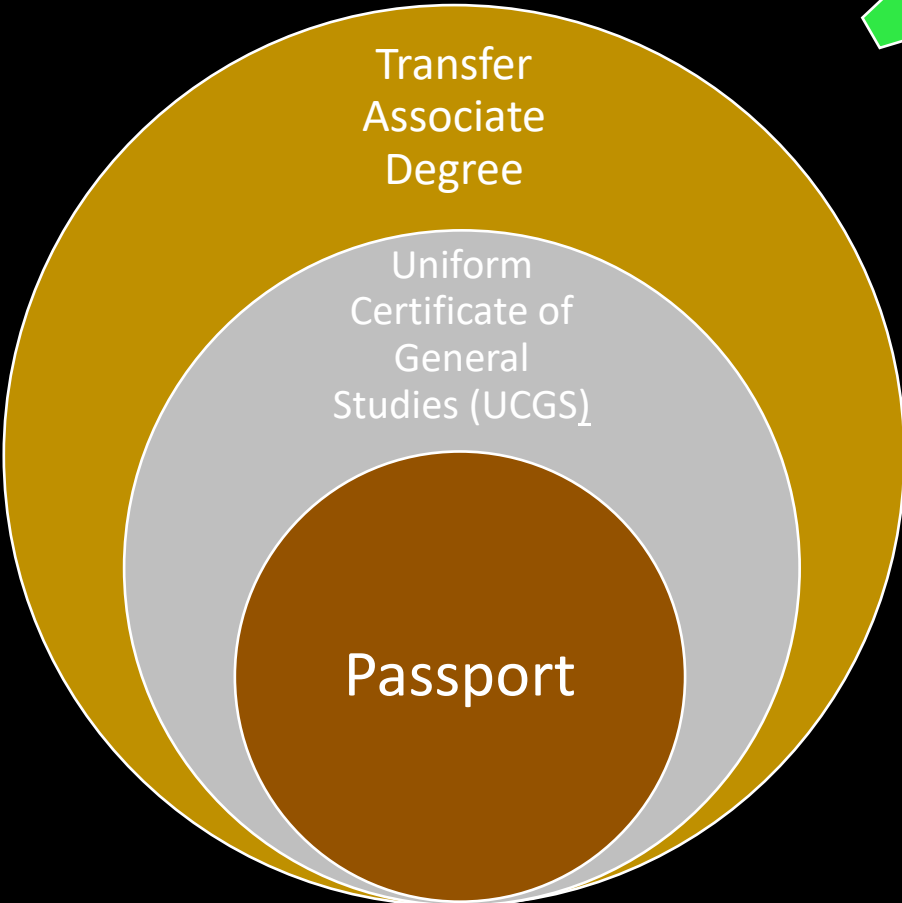
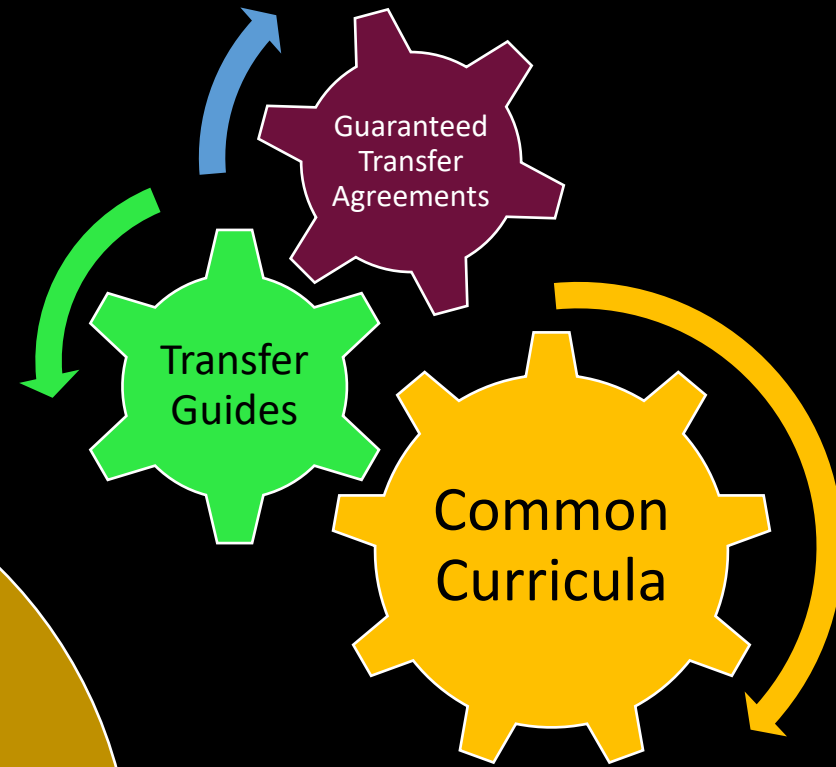
